Following a personal application made by Cllr Marianne Overton, IDEAS (and other community groups locally), has been awarded £200 from the Big Society Fund – Community Grants. Marianne is a great supporter of IDEAS and we are really grateful for all her efforts on our behalf. IDEAS net income now stands at well over £9,000 which has mainly been achieved by the various fund raising events held over the past 15 months and donations. Members of the IDEAS team are meeting with Directors of Branston Ltd. to discuss their donation of a piece of equipment to Dunston children's play area.
